Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 178 dated 19.07.2019 registered under Sections 147, 148, 149, 323, 341, 427, 506 and 307 IPC at Police Station Badhra, District Charkhi Dadri.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the injuries attributed to the petitioner is with *Binda* (thick wooden stick) on the leg of the Raju. The trial will take time. He fairly states that there are 6 other FIRs registered against the petitioner out of which in 2 he has been acquitted and in 4 FIRs he is on bail.

On the instruction from SI Prem Singh, learned State counsel states that charges are yet to be framed.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties and is of the view that the trial will take time to conclude and no useful purpose would be served by detaining the petitioner behind the bars.

In view of the above, without commenting anything on the merits of the case, which may not cause prejudice to either of the parties at a later stage, but taking the above facts into consideration, the petition is allowed and the petitioner-Mukesh is ordered to be released on regular bail to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
