The present petition has been filed seeking regular bail in FIR No.250 dated 10.10.2019, under Section 21(b) of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Kalanwali, District Sirsa, Haryana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that going by the contents of the FIR, total 600 tablets of Tramadol Hydrochloride of 100 mg. each were recovered and, therefore, by calculating the same, it would come to 60 gms., which is not a commercial quantity.

On the other hand, learned State counsel has submitted that the recovery has been effected from the petitioner and even without going into the calculation with regard to the alleged recovery, the matter is serious in nature and the petitioner does not deserve the concession of regular bail.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the record.

As per the contents of the FIR, a patrolling party when saw one person coming on the Motorcycle, stopped him and nabbed him. The aforesaid person disclosed his name as Swaran Singh son of Hakam Singh, resident of Near Sidhu Bazar Wali Gali, Mandi Kalanwali, who is the present petitioner. One plastic bag of white colour was hanging on the handle of the motorcycle. Notice under Section 50 of the NDPS Act was given to him and a search was conducted and 600 tablets of Tramadol Hydrochloride of 100 mg each were recovered. The alleged recovery has been made from the petitioner.

After considering the arguments raised by the learned counsel for the parties and the totality of circumstances, I do not deem fit to grant bail in the present case.

In view of the above, the present petition is hereby dismissed.

However, this is not to be treated as expression of any opinion or observations regarding the merits of the case.
