This order of mine shall dispose of CRM-M-53831-2019, filed by petitioner-Nishan Singh and CRM-M-54447-2019, filed by petitioner-Ninder Singh, under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.71 dated 08.09.2019, registered at Police Station Khalra, District Tarn Taran, under Sections 323, 324, 148 and 149 IPC and Sections 307 and 326 IPC added later on.

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Learned counsel for the petitioners states that pursuant to the orders dated 17.12.2019 and dated 19.12.2019 passed in CRM-M-53831-2019 and CRM-M-54447-2019, respectively, by this Court, the petitioners have joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Balwinder Singh, submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation and are not required for any further investigation.

Looking to the circumstances, but without commenting on the merits of the case, both the petitions are allowed and the orders dated 17.12.2019 and dated 19.12.2019 passed in CRM-M-53831-2019 and CRM-M-54447-2019, respectively, granting interim bail to the petitioners are made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
