Pursuant to the order of this court dated 19.12.2019, learned counsel for the petitioner has produced in court today the orders passed by the trial court prior to the date that the bail bonds furnished by the petitioner were ordered to be forfeited (i.e. before 15.05.2019).

A perusal thereof shows that after the petitioner had been admitted to bail by the trial court on 10.08.2018, he had not come present before that court on 25.02.2019, upon an application seeking exemption from personal appearance having been allowed, after which he again did not come present on 15.05.2019.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that pursuant to the order dated 19.12.2019 passed, the petitioner has now surrendered before the trial court and has been admitted to interim bail to its satisfaction.

That being so, subject to the petitioner continuously appearing before the trial court as and when summoned to do so, the present petition is

disposed of, with the order dated 19.12.2019 made absolute.
