The present petition is filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking grant of regular bail in FIR No.66 dated 29.5.2019 under Sections 323, 324, 307, 427, 148, 149 IPC, Police Station Nurpur Bedi, District Rupnagar.

On the last date of hearing, the petitioner was directed to file an affidavit.

Today, an application has been filed stating therein that no affidavit can be filed by the petitioner as he is in custody. However, he has given an undertaking that he will not issue any threat to the complainant party or to any witness in case he is released on bail. In any case, injuries in the present case are simple in nature and the co-accused is on bail. There is no reason to distinguish the case of the present petitioner.

In view of the above, this Court deems it proper to release the petitioner on bail to the satisfaction of the concerned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.

The petition stands allowed.
