Through this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. prayer has been made for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.416 dated 03.09.2019, registered under Sections 419, 420 and 120-B IPC, at Police Station Tosham, District Bhiwani.

According to prosecution, petitioner in conspiracy with her accomplice induces young unmarried boys on false pretext of getting solemnized their marriage. In the instant case, petitioner misrepresented herself to be the mother of bride Kulwinder Kaur, who after marriage, within a short time, fled away with cash and jewellery lying in the house of complainant.

Learned counsel contends that petitioner is in custody since 30.10.2019. Conclusion of trial may take a sufficient long time. No useful purpose would be served by detaining the petitioner any more in jail.

On the other hand, learned State counsel vehemently

opposed the grant of regular bail to the petitioner.

Considering overall facts and circumstances, but without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. Consequently, petitioner is ordered to be released on bail during pendency of trial, if not required in any other case, on her furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
