Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is to seek direction to official respondent Nos. 1 to 4 to conduct fair and impartial investigation in FIR No.0155 dated 14.11.2019, under Sections 363, 366-A IPC, registered at Police Station Partap Nagar, District Yamuna Nagar.

Power of attorney filed on behalf of respondent No.5 today in the Court, is taken on record.

Reply by way of affidavit of Shri Ashish Chaudhary, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Bilaspur (Yamuna Nagar) filed on behalf of respondent Nos. 1 to 4 today in the Court, is taken on record.

As per reply, after registration of the case, investigation has been carried out and houses of respondent Nos. 5 and 6 have been raided but they were not found in their houses. Meanwhile, petitioner has filed a petition bearing CRWP-2493-2019 with a prayer that directions be issued to the official respondents to get his daughter released from the illegal custody of respondent Nos. 5 and 6. Thereafter, SI Surinder Kumar visited the house of respondent No.6 along with Sarpanch of the village, but the daughter of the petitioner was not found in the house of respondent No.6. On 22.01.2020, SI Surinder Kumar visited the house of respondent No.5- Mohd. Israil in search of Shehnaaz, daughter of the petitioner and she was found there. Her statement was recorded. The alleged detainee has stated that she has solemnized marriage with Mohd. Israil with her own wish and she has not been detained by any person. While the matter was under investigation, respondent No.5 Mohd. Israil with whom the alleged detainee has solemnized the marriage, had also filed CRM-M-54457-2019, so as to grant him anticipatory bail in FIR No. 155 dated 14.11.2019 wherein arrest of Mohd. Israil was stayed and the said petition is coming up for hearing on 12.03.2020.

In view of the aforesaid details so submitted in the reply by Shri Ashish Chaudhary, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Bilaspur (Yamuna Nagar), learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition, at this stage.

Dismissed as not pressed.
