The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.50 dated 25.03.2017 registered under Sections 307, 224, 323, 332, 353, 427, 436, 186, 120-B, 148, 149 IPC and 52-A of the Prisons Act at Police Station City Gurdaspur, District Gurdaspur.

On 19.12.2019, the following order was passed:

“..Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner was granted regular bail and was facing the trial, however, on 13.10.2019, the mother of the petitioner had expired and therefore, he could not attend the Court proceedings on 16.10.2019. Counsel for the petitioner has further argued that the petitioner undertake that he will appear before the trial Court within a period of 15 days from today.

Notice of motion for 19.02.2020.

In the meantime, the petitioner is directed to appear before the trial Court within a period of 15 days from today and the trial Court will release the petitioner on interim bail subject to his furnishing fresh bail/surety bonds.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in pursuance to the order dated 19.12.2019, has already appeared before the

trial Court and he has been released on interim bail.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from SI Onkar Singh, has not disputed the aforesaid fact.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and order dated 19.12.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
