Petitioners have filed this petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.2 to 4 to safeguard their life and also a direction to respondent Nos.3 and 4 not to interfere in their life at the instance of respondent Nos.5 to 7, as they have solemnized marriage against the wishes of private respondents.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Naresh Kumar, has apprised the Court that the statements of the petitioners have been recorded, wherein they have stated that on 01.01.2020 again the marriage was performed as per the rituals with the consent of their parents. She has produced the original statements which are taken on record. She submits that in view of the stand of the petitioners, there is no threat to them as on today.

In view of the above, the petition is rendered infructuous.
