The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, in case FIR No. 329, dated 01.12.2014, under Section 304-B IPC, registered at Police Station Patti, District Tarn Taran, wherein, the petitioners have been summoned as additional accused under Section 319 Cr.P.C.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners, who are the close relatives of the main accused (husband of the complainant) were placed in column No.2. Initially, the application moved by the complainant for summoning the petitioners was dismissed by the learned trial Court on 30.11.2016, however, the said order was set aside by this Court in revision. It has been submitted that the custodial interrogation of the petitioners is not required, and they are ready to appear before the learned trial Court and face the trial. Hence, bail be granted to them.

Looking to all these circumstances, but without commenting

upon the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed and the

petitioners are directed to appear before the trial Court/Duty Magistrate on or before the date fixed before the trial court. On doing so, they shall be admitted to bail on their furnishing of adequate bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
