Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in complaint No.COMA/1001/2016 dated 02.05.2016 and CRA/69/2019 titled as Amit Monga Vs. Andhra Bank & Anr.” against order dated 22.11.2019 and 05.12.2019 vide which warrants of arrest have been issued against him.

On 21.01.2020, the following order was passed by the Court:

“As per office report, notice issued to respondent No.1 has not been received back either served or otherwise.

Let fresh notice be issued to respondent No.1 for 20.02.2020.

In the meantime, the petitioner shall appear before the learned Appellate Court on or before 03.02.2020 and upon his appearance, the Appellate Court shall admit him on interim regular bail on his furnishing requisite bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of that Court.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in compliance of the order dated 21.01.2020, the petitioner submitted himself before the trial Court on 03.02.2020. He has produced the copy of the order dated 03.02.2020 passed by trial Court, whereby the petitioner was released on interim regular bail.

Learned State counsel does not dispute the above fact and stated that the petitioner submitted himself before the trial Court on 03.02.2020 and furnished the bail bonds and surety bonds.

Considering the above, the petition is allowed and the order dated 21.01.2020 is made absolute. Further the petitioner be allowed to remain on the bail bonds and surety bonds furnished by him before the trial Court on 03.02.2020.
