This order of mine shall dispose of CRM-M-53872-2019, filed
by petitioner-Happy Singh @ Tindy, and CRM-M-395-2020, filed by
petitioner-Manpreet Singh @ Mani, seeking anticipatory bail in FIR

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District Bathinda, under Sections 323, 324, 326, 506, 148 and 149 IPC.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that pursuant to the orders dated 17.12.2019 passed in CRM-M-53872-2019 and dated 09.01.2020 passed in CRM-M-395-2020, the petitioners have joined the investigation, respectively.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sadhu Singh, submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation and are not required for any further investigation.

At this stage, the learned counsel for the complainant submits that petitioner-Happy Singh @ Tindy had given a sword blow to the complainant, which hit him on the fingers of his right hand, whereas injuries inflicted upon the complainant and injured-Baltej Singh by petitioner-Manpreet Singh @ Mani were on the finger of right hand and under the shoulder, respectively. Due to which, the little finger of right hand of complainant has been amputated. However, he does not dispute that it is a case of version and cross-version and the petitioner's side (accused) has also received injuries.

Looking to the circumstances, but without commenting on the merits of the case, both the petitions are allowed and the orders dated 17.12.2019 passed in CRM-M-53872-2019 and dated 09.01.2020 passed in CRM-M-395-2020, granting interim bail to the petitioners, are made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

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However, nothing stated above shall be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
