The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, in case FIR No.137 dated 11.09.2019 under Sections 376/506 IPC registered at Police Station Women, Yamuna Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case and the allegations have been concocted by the complainant as he neither allured her for marriage nor subjected her to any sexual assault much less rape.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, no ground is made out for grant of anticipatory bail as the allegations levelled against the petitioner are very serious and the petitioner has been specifically named in the statement of the prosecutrix recorded under Section 164 Cr.PC before the Court. Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed.
