Present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India has been filed by petitioners-Shalu and Ajay. They have pleaded that they want to marry and seek protection to their life and liberty as they apprehend danger from respondents No. 4 to 8. The petitioners have submitted representation dated 03.09.2019, Annexure P-3 to respondent No. 2.

Vide order dated 04.09.2019, the learned State counsel was directed to file reply in response to the petition.

In compliance thereof, reply by way of affidavit of Vinod Shanker, DSP, Kalayat, has been filed. As per the reply, respondent No. 4-Sudesh and respondent No. 5-Tilak Raj in their statements have stated that they have no objection regarding the relationship of the petitioners and they will not interfere in their life and liberty. Moreover, as per the reply, the petitioners in their statements have stated that now they have no apprehension of any danger from the respondents and they are not in need of any police protection and did not want any legal action against the respondent and are living peacefully.

In view of the above, no further order is called for in the matter. It is made clear that this order shall not be taken to protect the petitioners from legal action for violation of law if any committed by them.
