1. Result of the petitioner for the post of Lower Division Clerk in UHBVNL/ DHBVNL, against Advertisement No. 3/2016, category No. 3 has been produced in sealed cover in Court alongwith cut-off marks obtained by the last selected candidate which on opening reveals petitioner to have secured 106 marks as against 113/117 marks obtained by the last candidate selected in General category in UHBVNL/DHBVNL. It further reveals that candidates having secured 100/110 marks have been kept in waiting list in UHBVNL/DHBVNL respectively.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of the marks obtained by the petitioner, the writ petition may be disposed of by directing the respondents to take follow up action for the post of Lower Division Clerk in UHBVNL, in accordance with law.

3. Learned Sr. DAG, Haryana states that he has no objection to the limited prayer of the petitioner.

4. In view of the position as noted above, the writ petition is disposed of by directing the respondents to take follow-up action on the result of the petitioner for the post of Lower Division Clerk in UHBVNL in accordance with law as expeditiously as possible preferably within four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

5. Writ petition disposed of in the afore-mentioned terms.
