Petitioners have filed this petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to protect their life and liberty and not to interfere in their matrimonial life at the instance of respondent Nos. 4 to 8.

On 17.12.2019, learned State counsel was directed to find out the existence of alleged threat. In response thereto, she stated that during enquiry, statements of the petitioners as well as respondent Nos.4 to 8 were recorded by the police. Petitioners in their statements have stated that they have no danger to their life. They expressed that they do not need any protection from the police. Private respondent Nos.4 to 8 in their statements recorded separately stated that they have no objection to the marriage performed by the petitioners. Copies of the statements have been taken on

record.

In view of the above, nothing survives for adjudication in this petition, which is rendered infructuous.
