Present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.519 dated 19.07.2019 under Sections 306, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Model Town, District Panipat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the husband of the petitioner had committed suicide and FIR was lodged on the complaint of her father-in-law. He has further submitted that the petitioner is a young lady and she has two daughters aged about 5-1/2 years and 2 years. She is in custody since 19.08.2019.

Learned State counsel has not disputed the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner, but he submits that there are serious allegations against the accused and no case for bail is made out.

I have considered the rival submissions.

The petitioner is behind bars for the last more than four months. She is young lady aged 28 years and is mother of two very young daughters who require her care and attention. Therefore, further detention of the petitioner will not be in the interest of the minors.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be admitted on regular bail on furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of concerned learned trial Court.
