Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.278 dated 11.11.2019 under Sections 341,342, 506, 376, 34 IPC and Section 4 and 10 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012, registered at Police Station Bawal, District Rewari, Haryana.

Vide order dated 18.12.2019, the petitioner was granted *ad interim* bail and was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to aforesaid order of this Court, the petitioner has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is no more required.

Learned State counsel does not dispute the aforesaid facts.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Considering the fact that the petitioner has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is no more required, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 18.12.2019 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when directed by the investigating agency and shall abide by the terms and conditions laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
