Through the instant petition, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 222 dated 21.11.2019, registered under Sections 22/29, of NDPS Act, 1985, Police Station Sadar Sangrur, District Sangrur.

Vide order dated 18.12.2019 , the petitioner was granted interim bail and was directed to join the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Balwinder Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined investigation and is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above facts, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated

18.12.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject

to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
