Reply by way of affidavit of Mr. Yogesh Kumar, PPS,
Deputy Superintendent of Police, City-I, Patiala on behalf of
respondents No.1 to 3 has been filed in Court. The same is
taken on record.

As per para No.3 of the aforesaid reply, the Police has
verified the date of birth of alleged detainee Loveleen Chandla,
who is found to be 18 years of age as on 15.01.2020.

At this stage, detenue Loveleen Chandla along with respondent No.4 appears in Court. She states that she is 18 years of age and has not been kidnapped by respondent No.4- Sunny Singh, rather she will go along with him.

In view of above, without making any opinion in respect of the validity of marriage or otherwise, I deem it appropriate to dispose of this case as the custody of Loveleen Chandla is not found to be illegal.
