This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.16 dated 9.2.2019, under Sections 323, 325, 326, 148, 149, 120-B IPC, Police Station Sadar Hoshiarpur, District Hoshiarpur.

A perusal of the case file shows that for the same relief, the petitioner had earlier filed CRM-M-29045 of 2019 which was dismissed as withdrawn on 11.7.2019. As the petitioner failed to join the investigation in the aforesaid FIR, the trial Court, on 31.10.2019, declared him Proclaimed Offender.

This Court finds that the present petition has been filed without any valid cause of action and that too after the petitioner was declared Proclaimed Offender, therefore, no case is made out to grant the extraordinary concession of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner.

Resultantly, the petition is dismissed. The petitioner is burdened with cost of ₹10,000/- to be deposited with the Punjab & Haryana

High Court Employees Welfare Association, High Court, Chandigarh within two months from today.
