(1) The petitioner-Bahadur Singh has filed the present writ petition, *inter alia*, challenging the order dated 25.10.2019 (Annexure P-2), whereby the petitioner was served with a premature retirement notice.

(2) During the pendency of the writ petition, premature retirement order has been passed.

(3) In this view of the matter, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for permission to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to file a fresh writ petition challenging the impugned order of premature retirement.

(4) Permission is granted with liberty as aforesaid.

(5) Learned counsel for the petitioner also submits that on 19.02.2020 in '*CWP No.36936 of 2019 titled as Robin Masih Vs. State of Punjab and others*' similar directions were given.

(6) Accordingly, writ petition is disposed of with the aforesaid liberty.
