Petitioner seeks grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.154 dated 12.10.2019 under Sections 379-B (2), 341 and 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Division Jodhewal, District Police Commissionerate Ludhiana.

In respect of occurrence dated 02.10.2019, FIR came to be registered on 12.10.2019. According to the allegations, the complainant was coming back home, when he reached Azad Nagar Turning point, then two persons restrained him from back side and forcibly snatched Rs.11,000/- in cash along with Mobile Realme-3 and ATM Card by showing knife. The petitioner along with co-acused Lucky was allegedly identified by the complainant as petitioner and Lucky after registration of the FIR.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Nirvail

Singh, states that despite moving specific application for grant of remand, no remand was granted and no recovery could be effected from the petitioner.

Learned State counsel further states that as per police file, the petitioner is not involved in any other case. Co-accused Lucky has not been arrested. Challan has been presented against the petitioner.

Petitioner is in custody since 13.10.2019.

The trial of the case may take some time in its culmination.

At this stage, without forming any opinion on the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to release the petitioner on regular bail.

In view of above, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be enlarged on bail, subject to his furnishing adequate bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.

Nothing expressed hereinabove shall be construed to be an opinion on merits of the case.
