This appeal has been filed against an order dated 21.11.2019 passed by the learned Single Judge in CWP-33917-2019 dismissing the writ petition filed by the petitioner seeking protection.

From a perusal of the record, it is apparent that the appellant has filed FIRs against respondent No. 4 which have been registered. It is evident that respondent No. 4 has also lodged an FIR against the appellant which is pending investigation.

In these circumstances, we are of the considered opinion that no direction, at this stage, is required to be issued to the authorities, as prayed for.

However, the appeal is disposed of only with an observation that in case the appellant files an application before the concerned police officer(s) seeking protection, the matter may be examined in that perspective and necessary orders be passed or decision in that regard be taken in accordance with law.

As the main appeal itself has been disposed of, no orders are required to be passed in CM-4757-LPA-2019 for permission to produce on record Annexure A-1 by way of additional evidence.
