The petitioners pray for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 113 dated 02.09.2018, registered under Sections 325, 323, 427, 341, 201, 506, 308, 148, 149 of the IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on) at Police Station Division No. 2, Pathankot.

On 18.12.2019, the following order was passed:

“Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that before adding Section 326 IPC, the petitioners were granted the concession of anticipatory bail vide order dated 12.07.2019 passed in CRM-M-24521-2019. It is further submitted that similarly situated co-accused Hanish Kumar @ Avineesh has already been granted the concession of interim anticipatory bail vide order dated 13.12.2019 passed in CRM-M-53319-2019. Notice of motion for 16.01.2020. To be listed along with CRM-M-53319-2019. In the meantime, the petitioners are directed to appear before the trial Court within a period of 10 days from today and they will be released on interim bail

subject to their furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.”

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners, in pursuance to the order dated 18.12.2019, have already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and have joined the investigation. It is also submitted that the petitioners have already paid a sum of Rs. 25,000/- each to victim Shiva.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Ram Lal, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation and are no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioners, vide order dated 18.12.2019, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
