The petitioner had filed CRM-M-36051-2018 for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 3 for taking appropriate action against respondents No.4 to 6 on the basis of his complaint dated 28.05.2018.

Vide order dated 21.08.2018, Coordinate Bench of this Court had disposed of the petition with direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Fazilka to look into the matter and to dispose of the complaint dated 28.05.2018 moved by the petitioner, expeditiously preferably within a period of three months from 21.08.2018 in accordance with law.

The registry has put up this case as respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Fazilka had requested for extension of time to complete the inquiry on the complaint dated 28.05.2018 moved by the petitioner.

Learned State counsel has submitted that in compliance with the order dated 21.08.2018, FIR No.90 dated 31.12.2018 under Sections 193, 406, 409, 465, 467, 471 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short, "IPC") and Section 13(1) of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 has been registered at Police Station Sadar Abohar, District Fazilka and on completion of investigation, report

under Section 173(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 has been
filed which is pending trial.
