RAMENDRA JAIN, J. (Oral)

Through instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. prayer has been made for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in a case arising from FIR No.192 dated 21.04.2017, registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 IPC, at Police Station Shahabad, District Kurukshetra.

According to prosecution, petitioner issued a forged and fabricated insurance policy, produced by Harjinder, insured. When, on verification, said insurance policy was found false, learned Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Kurukshetra ordered to register FIR and investigate the matter.

During investigation, the petitioner was found guilty for issuing forged and fabricated policy in question.

Heard.

Petitioner is also involved in a similar case registered

against him at Rajasthan. Therefore, it is apparent that he is an habitual offender for issuing forged and fabricated insurance policy.

Considering the overall facts and circumstances, no ground exists to grant the concession of bail to the petitioner.

Dismissed.
