Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.51 dated 09.02.2019 under Sections 406, 420 read with Section 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Madhuban, District Kaithal.

While granting interim bail to the petitioner, following order was passed by this Court on 24.12.2019: -

“...Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that opening lines of the FIR itself shows that a complaint had been filed alleging forgery and cheating against Ankur Gupta, Harsh Gupta and Rajesh Singla. He further submits that Ankur Gupta and Harsh Gupta have already been granted the concession of anticipatory bail vide order dated 30.09.2019 (Annexure P-4).

Notice of this case was issued on 20.12.2019.

Learned State counsel submits that various efforts had been made to direct the petitioner to join investigation, but, his house was lying locked. He further submits that as per the allegations in the FIR, he has to pay huge amount to the complainant-Vikesh Batra.”

There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Harikishan, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for any further investigation. It is further submitted that two co-accused of the petitioner, namely Ankur Gupta and Harsh Gupta have already been granted the concession of anticipatory bail.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 24.12.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
