Through this petition, the petitioners seek regular bail in case FIR No.118 dated 22.05.2015, registered at Police Station Sadar Narwana, under Sections 457, 380, 427, 436, 447, 148, 149 and 506 IPC.

At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioners points that the petitioners were earlier declared proclaimed offenders on 16.12.2015, alongwith six other co-accused. They surrendered before the trial Court on 07.05.2019. He further states that vide judgment dated 22.09.2017 passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Jind, co-accused have already been acquitted of the charges.

Learned State counsel, on instructions of ASI Kuldeep Singh, submits that supplementary challan has been presented and out of 21 prosecution witnesses, none has been examined, and the case before the trial

Court has been fixed for 21.03.2020.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

The petitioners have been in custody since 07.05.2019. The trial of the case would take time to conclude. Therefore, no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioners behind the bars.

Without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail on their furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
