Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.248 dated 30.10.2019 under Sections 498-A and 323 IPC registered at Police Station City Kharar, S.A.S. Nagar, Mohali.

Vide order dated December 19, 2019 passed by this Court, while staying the arrest of the petitioner, the matter was referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court, where the petitioner and respondent No.2 were directed to appear on 16.01.2020.

A report dated 07.02.2020 has been received from the Mediator, wherein it is mentioned that the parties have settled their dispute by way of amicable settlement vide settlement/compromise dated 07.02.2020.

In view of the fact that the matter has been compromised between the parties before the Mediator, the present petition is allowed and

the order dated December 19, 2019 whereby arrest of the petitioner was stayed by this Court, is made absolute.

The parties shall adhere to the terms of the settlement/compromise dated 07.02.2020.

However, in case the petitioner is required in the case in any manner, a clear 15 days notice shall be served upon him.
