Vide order dated 09.05.2018 (Annexure P-6), request of the petitioner for permission to cut the trees on the land in his possession has been denied on the ground that the petitioner is not the land owner. The instructions framed under the Punjab Land Preservation Act, 1900 specify that for permission to cut trees the applicant must be the owner of the land on which the trees are standing.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that the instructions are ultra vires the Punjab Land Preservation Act, 1900. However, there is no prayer for quashing of the instructions. Under the circumstances, no relief can be granted to the petitioner.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file fresh one on the same cause of action.

Dismissed as withdrawn with aforementioned liberty.
