The present petition has been filed under Section 3(1)(d) of the Haryana Good Conduct Prisoners (Temp., Release) Act, 1988, by the petitioner to release him on emergency parole for four weeks to attend his ailing daughter, aged about 11 years.

Status report by way of affidavit of Deputy Superintendent, District Jail, Faridabad on behalf of the respondent-State filed in Court is taken on record. As per the status report, the case of the petitioner's daughter has not been found to be of emergent nature but she has been advised further investigation.

Heard.

Considering the fact that the petitioner is father of the ailing child, who requires immediate medical help, the petitioner being father is under obligation to arrange the funds and emotional support to the child, thus this Court feels it appropriate to accept this petition.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is granted parole for three weeks subject to furnishing surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Duty Magistrate, concerned. The petitioner shall surrender before the jail authorities on the date and time to be noticed by the releasing Court/Duty Magistrate.
