By this petition, the petitioners are seeking direction to respondent to consider their services for regularization and decide the legal notice dated 09.10.2019 (Annexure P-7).

The case of the petitioners is that they are working as Peon/Sweeper cum Chowkidar/Water Carrier being class-IV employees on part time basis and they have completed more than 6 years service continuously.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has referred to judgment passed in **CWP-16086-2019** titled as ***Pushpa Devi V/s. State of Haryana and others*** and submitted that pursuant to this judgment, the Committee has been set up and the case of the petitioners for regularization is pending.

The petitioners also sent a legal notice dated 09.10.2019 (Annexure P-7) seeking direction to the respondents to regularize their services because they have completed more than 6 years of service while working on part time basis and they are eligible for regularization as per policies for the years 1998, 1992, 2003 and 2004. Further their case is

squarely covered by the order passed in ***CWP No. 32932 of 2019*** titled as ***Gopal Singh V/s. State of Haryana and others.***

Notice of motion.

Mr. Kiran Pal Singh, Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents. A copy of the paper book be handed over to him during the course of the day.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is being disposed of by giving direction to the respondents to consider the case of the petitioners as per instructions/policy (Annexure P-2 collectively). This exercise be completed within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. If no order is passed, costs of Rs.25,000/- will be paid to each petitioner in order to avoid petitioners to run from pillar to post to get the order complied.
