This petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 180 dated 09.11.2019, registered under Sections 379-B, 411, 414 of the IPC at Police Station City-I Sangrur, District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per the allegations in the FIR, the petitioner, along with her co-accused, committed the offence of snatching during the time when a religious procession was going on.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner is in judicial custody since 23.11.2019 and she is no more required for any further custodial investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that co-accused Parkash Chand, Sukhwinder Kaur @ Jailo and Tauni have already been granted concession of anticipatory bail by this Court, vide orders of the even date passed in CRM-M-52357-2019 and CRM-M-51717-

2019, respectively.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Avtar Singh, has not disputed the factual position and submitted that petitioner is involved in one more case/FIR, however, she is on bail in that case.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, considering the fact that the petitioner is in judicial custody since 23.11.2019; co-accused have already been granted concession of anticipatory bail by this Court as noticed above and also in view of the fact that conclusion of trial is likely to take some time, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on her furnishing bail/surety to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
