Petitioners have filed this petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to protect their life and liberty from the hands of respondent Nos.4 and 5 and also directing respondent Nos.2 and 3 not to interfere in their peaceful married life.

On 20.12.2019, learned State counsel was directed to find out the existence of alleged threat. Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Manbir Kaur, has apprised the Court that the statements of the petitioners were recorded, wherein they stated that they do not have any threat as on today, much less from the private respondents, who have also not objected to the alleged marriage between the petitioners. This fact is not disputed by the learned counsel for the petitioners.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioners does not press this petition.

Dismissed as not pressed.
