Through this petition, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No.188 dated 03.05.2018, registered at Police Station Sector 39, Chandigarh, under Sections 420 and 120-B IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner, who was employed in a firm namely BMA(Bhuramal Aggarwal) and performing the duty of calling the prospective customers and explaining the benefits of insurance policies. He had nothing to do with the amount, which had been allegedly taken away, as per the complaint, by him.

On the other hand, learned Addl. P.P. U.T. Chandigarh, submits that during investigation, it has come to the light that the complainant had invested Rs.11,77,000/- in the bank account of different companies and out

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of the said amount, a sum of Rs.1,34,000/- was deposited in the bank account of the petitioner.

I have heard the learned counsel for the petitioner.

Keeping in view the fact that the amount has been allegedly deposited in the bank account of the petitioner, which was got opened on 07.11.2013 and is still being operated, I find that to unearth the role played by him, the petitioner is required for custodial interrogation.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
