The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR

proceedings pending under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act and apply for fresh bail.

Notice of motion for 16.03.2020.

In the meantime, the petitioner is directed to surrender before the trial Court in the proceedings pending under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, within a period of 10 days from today and the trial Court will release the petitioner on interim bail subject to his furnishing fresh bail/surety bonds.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in pursuance to the order dated 10.01.2020, has already appeared before the trial Court and he has been released on interim bail.

Learned counsel for the State has not disputed the aforesaid fact.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and order dated 10.01.2020 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
