The instant petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking direction to official respondent Nos.2 and 3 to protect the lives and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents no.4 and 5 who are stated to be relatives of petitioner No.1, as the petitioners solemnized marriage against their wishes.

Vide order dated 20.12.2019, this Court while issuing notice of motion, directed to respondent No.2 to look into the threat perception to the lives and liberty of the petitioners and take appropriate action in accordance with law.

As per status report dated 25.02.2020 filed by the State, statements of the private respondents as well as petitioner No.2 have been recorded in compliance to the order dated 20.12.2019, wherein they stated that they have no objection to the marriage solemnized by the petitioners. Further, petitioner No.2 has also stated that his wife, petitioner No.1 has gone abroad for study. He and his family have now no danger from the family of his in-laws.

In view of the above, this petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
