The petitioner is the Gram Panchayat, who has made a prayer for issuance of writ of mandamus, directing the respondents No.4 to 8 to demarcate the Gram Panchayat land, for the purpose of marking/numberation of the trees standing in the land for getting the permit in terms of the Management Plan of private forest area under Sections 4 and 5 of the Punjab Land Preservation Act, 1900 (Annexure P-2) and also to direct respondent No.3 to issue necessary permit for which the petitioner has already applied in terms of the Management Plan.

Notice of motion was issued in this case on 20.12.2020. Pursuant to which, Ms. Ambika Sood, DAG, Punjab has put in appearance on behalf of all the respondents and submitted that the demarcation has been ordered by the competent authority to be conducted through Satnam Singh, Kanugoo. It is ordered that demarcation shall be done by Satnam Singh, Kanugoo, who is present in Court, by associating Gram Panchayat within a

period of two weeks from the date of passing of this order.

In view thereof, the present petition is dismissed as infructuous.
