Present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.120 dated 06.07.2019 under Section 379-B IPC, registered at Police Station Division B, Amritsar, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has urged that the petitioner is in custody since 06.07.2019 and he is a young boy aged 19 years.

Learned State counsel opposed the petition on the ground that earlier also, the petitioner was involved in a case under Sections 323 and 324 IPC though he was later acquitted. He has further submitted that the investigation is complete and challan has been presented though the charges could not be framed since the co-accused had been declared proclaimed offender on 05.10.2019.

I have considered the rival submissions.

The petitioner is behind the bars for the last more than six months and he is young boy aged 19 years and a long life ahead of him. The trial of the case will take some more time and further detention of the petitioner will not serve any useful purpose.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be admitted on regular bail on furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of concerned learned trial Court.
