Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.95 dated 15.11.2019 registered under Sections 323, 354, 406, 498-A and 506 of IPC at Women Police Station, District Sonapat.

Vide order dated 20.12.2019, while issuing notice of motion in the case, the matter was referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court and the arrest of the petitioner was stayed.

Pursuant to aforesaid order, parties appeared before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court and a report dated 11.02.2020 has been received from the Mediator that the parties have settled their dispute by way of settlement/agreement dated 11.02.2020.

Memorandum of appearance filed on behalf of respondent No.2 in court today, is taken on record. Counsel appearing on behalf of respondent No.2 has not disputed the factum of compromise between the parties.

In view of the fact that the matter has been compromised between the parties, the order dated 20.12.2019 whereby arrest of the petitioner was stayed, is made absolute.

However, in case the petitioner is required in the case in any manner, a clear 15 days notice shall be given to him.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
