[1] Prayer in the writ petition is for the issuance of a writ of mandamus for directing the respondents to provide the information sought for by the petitioner vide his application (Annexure P-1) dated 05.07.2018 but the same has not been supplied and the second appeal i.e. Annexure P-4 dated 12.12.2018 filed by the petitioner has not been decided by respondent No.1, till date.

[2] Learned counsel states that the petitioner would be satisfied, if the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.1 to consider and decide the appeal (Annexure P-4) dated 12.12.2018, in accordance with law in a time bound manner.

[3] Without commenting upon the merits of the claim, the writ petition is ***disposed of*** by directing respondent No.1 to consider and decide the appeal (Annexure P-4) dated 12.12.2018, in accordance with law, after taking into account all aspect of the matter, as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of 03 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.
