The petitioner assails the order dated 28.12.2018 (Annexure P-22) passed by the General Manager, Human Resources Management Department of the National Bank for Agriculture and Rural Development (NABARD) whereby he was dismissed from service. He seeks a further direction to reinstate him in service with all consequential benefits.

Admittedly, the petitioner already preferred an appeal against the impugned dismissal order dated 28.12.2018 (Annexure P-22). This appeal was filed on 23.04.2019 and is stated to be pending consideration before the Chairman-cum-Managing Director of the Bank, viz., the designated Appellate Authority.

As the petitioner's appeal is yet to be decided by the Appellate

Authority, it would be pre-mature for this Court to entertain this writ petition and look into the validity of the impugned dismissal order.

Further, as this Court does not propose to go into the merits of the matter and in the light of the order proposed to be passed hereunder, it is not necessary to put the respondents on notice at this stage or afford them an opportunity of hearing.

The writ petition is accordingly disposed of directing the Appellate Authority to consider the petitioner's appeal dated 23.04.2019 on merits and dispose of the same expeditiously, if not already disposed of. Such exercise shall be completed preferably within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
