Lisa Gill, J.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in terms of the applicable regulations, a short validity passport for a period of two years can be issued to the petitioner, provided the required formalities are carried out by him.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the required formalities shall be carried out by the petitioner within fifteen (15) days from today and it is prayed that the said passport for two years be, thus, issued to him.

Keeping in view the specific stand of the parties, this writ petition is disposed of with the observations that in case the petitioner carries out the necessary formalities, as mentioned by learned counsel for the respondent within fifteen (15) days, the authorities shall consider issuance of the short validity passport for a period of two years and necessary steps in this regard shall be taken by the authorities within four weeks of completion of the formalities by the petitioner.
