Learned counsel for the appellant submits that the appellant-petitioner needs water to irrigate his land. The petitioner had challenged the orders passed by the authorities, whereby some other persons have been granted water facility from his personal water course. It is submitted that the *lis* still survives, but the learned Single Judge has disposed of the matter on the ground that petitioner has set up a solar power plant, which issue has nothing to do with the right of the petitioner to irrigate his fields, for which he needs water. It is further submitted that this aspect has escaped consideration of the learned Single Judge.
