The petitioners pray for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.186 dated 18.10.2019, registered under Sections 341, 323, 506, 148, 149 IPC (Sections 307 and 325 IPC added later) at Police Station Sadar Sangrur, District Sangrur.

The operative part of the order dated 23.12.2019, vide which interim anticipatory bail has been granted to the petitioners, is reproduced as under:-

“...Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioner No.1 is not attributed any injury and the injury attributed to petitioner No.2 is on non-vital part of the body...”

Counsel for the petitioners has submitted that, in pursuance to the order dated 23.12.2019, the petitioners have appeared before the Investigating Officer and have joined the investigation.

Counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Sukhjinder

Singh, has not disputed the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioners are no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioners vide order dated 23.12.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Counsel for the petitioners, at this stage, has argued that Section 201 IPC has now been added in the FIR and the same may be added in the headnote and prayer clause of the main petition in addition to Sections 341, 323, 506, 148, 149, 307 and 325 IPC.

The Registry is directed to make necessary addition in the headnote and prayer clause of the main petition.

It is clarified that this order shall be read as '*granting bail to the petitioners under Sections 341, 323, 506, 148, 149, 307, 325 and 201 IPC.*'
