Prayer of the petitioner reads as under: -

'Civil Writ Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for the issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents No. 1 to 3 not to pass any adverse order on the Letter dated 06.12.2019 sent by respondent No. 2 to respondent No. 1 (Annexure P-18) till the decision of writ petitions i.e., CWP No. 19893/2019, CWP No. 24083/2019, CWP No. 27822/2019 pending before this Hon'ble Court.'

It is an admitted fact that the petitioner herein filed the pending writ petitions, viz., CWP-19893-2019, CWP-24083-2019 and CWP-27822-2019. It is her prayer in the present writ petition that the respondent authorities should be restrained from passing an adverse order till a decision is rendered in the earlier writ petitions filed by her.

The petitioner can as well seek such relief in the pending writ petitions but instead of doing so, she filed the present writ petition seeking relief which is practically in the form of interim relief pending disposal of her earlier writ petitions.

The writ petition is utterly misconceived and is accordingly dismissed.
