Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail, pending trial in case FIR No.56 dated 31.05.2018, under Sections 21, 25 and 29 N.D.P.S.Act, 1985, registered at Police Station, Jhabal, District Tarn Taran.

As per the allegations in the FIR, on 31.05.2018, the police party apprehended the accused persons, namely, Mukhtar Singh @ Kala and Lakhwinder Singh @ Kaka (petitioner), who were riding on black coloured motor cycle without number plate and were coming from the side of Village Panjwar at fast speed, and upon their search by police, 255 grams of heroin was recovered.

Learned State counsel has produced the custody certificate of the petitioner by way of affidavit of Baljit Singh, PPS, Deputy

Superintendent, Central Jail, Amritsar and it indicates that he is involved in other cases of similar nature. No case is made out for grant of regular bail to the petitioner.

The petition is dismissed.
