The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of bail pending trial in case FIR No.145 dated 14.09.2019 registered under Sections 341, 324, 323, 148 & 149 of IPC (Section 326 IPC, added later on) at Police Station Kamboj, Amritsar Rural, District Amritsar.

It is contended by the counsel for the petitioner that the case against the petitioner is concocted for motivated reasons. In fact, the son of the petitioner had lodged a complaint against the complainant of the present case. As a matter of revenge; the name of the petitioner has been dragged in this case. Still further it is submitted that even as per the allegations the attribution to the petitioner is of *datar* blow on left thigh and left knee of the complainant. However, both these injuries have been opined to be simple in nature. The petitioner is in custody since 12.11.2019. The evidence has not even started. Therefore, the matter is

likely to take long time for conclusion. The petitioner is not required for any investigation purposes. Hence, the petitioner deserves to be released on bail.

On the other hand, counsel for the State, on instructions, submits that the petitioner has been attributed two specific injuries to the complainant. However, it is not disputed that both the injuries are simple in nature; and further; that the petitioner is in custody since 12.11.2019.

In view the above, but without expressing any further opinion on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail pending trial subject to his furnishing bail bonds/surety to the satisfaction of the Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
