CRM M-55426 of 2019

Through instant 1st petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., prayer
has been made for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR
No.83 dated 19.05.2019 under Sections 307, 324, 323, 341, 506, 148, 149
of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 326 IPC added later on,
registered at Police Station Sadar Sangrur District Sangrur.

According to the prosecution, petitioner along with his
accomplice attacked the complainant party. They caused multiple, simple
and grievous injuries. The role attributed to the petitioner is raising of a
'*lalkara*' not to spare the complainant party and giving a iron blow on the
head of Harbans Singh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case. Injury attributed to the petitioner has been found simple in nature. Final report under Section 173(2) Cr.P.C. has been filed. Therefore, the petitioner is not required for any further custodial interrogation.

On the contrary to it, learned State counsel assisted by learned counsel for the complainant, refuting the above said submissions contends that the petitioner is involved in 20 more cases of heinous nature. Recovery of arm has to be effected from him. Therefore, he is required for custodial interrogation.

Considering overall facts and circumstances, the petitioner does not deserve concession of anticipatory bail.

Dismissed.
